the said George Parker and Henry Johnson their Execut. and Administrators in
Prison to hold and keep until payment thereof to be made with all Cess & Damages
sustained and to be susetyed of occasion of the same and upon paymt thereof the
said George Parker and Henry Johnson their Execut. and adm^ts forth of Prison to
discharge and acquittances for the same or any part thereof for me and in my
name to make and deliver And also to doe Perform and Execute all and every
other lawfull and Reasonable acts and things whatsoever both for obeyning
and discharging of the same as shall be needfull to be done & having and by
these presents Granting unto my said Attorney my full and absolute Power
in the premises Ratifying and Holding firm all and whatsoever my said Attorney
shall doe or cause to be done in or about the premises by virtue of these presents
