name and behalfe in open Court or before one or more of his Lopp<sup>s</sup> privye  
council as the Lawe doth require a certaine conveyance by me past onto  
the said Michael Tid for the said tract of Land Ratifying and allowing the  
acknowledgement of Israell Shelton my true & lawfull attorney in this case  
as if I had been there personally present In witness whereof I haue hereunto
