 one yeares & now being twenty and two yedres of age have aliene sold &

 County doe hereby constitute impower & authorize my well and beloved freind

 name and behalfe in open Court or before one or more of his Lopp<sup>s</sup> privy  
 Councell as the Law doth require a certaine conveyance by me past unto  
 the said Michaell Tud for the said tract of Land Ratifyeing and allowing the  
 acknowledgement of Israell Skelton my true & Lawfull attorney in this case  
 as if I had been there personally present In witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this 23<sup>th</sup> day of May Annoq<sup>3</sup> Domini 1685.
