

to the then next Court to be held for the said City affaire List of the Names
 & surnames of all and singular the freemen & servants and Negroes inhabiting
 there that soe the Court may further order therein as to them shall seem meet
 and the same to be returned to the Councill upon making up the Publick Levy
 for such year. And the Levy to be layd upon the taxables of the said City,
 when occasion require.

Item. It alsoe is hereby ordeyned Enacted & Established that the Constable of the
 Said City for the time being shall on the last Saturday in every Month to
 Comence from the date hereof goe in and upon the severall roads & highwaies
 leading to, in & about the said City and view & see the same roads, and if
 occasion require to take with him sufficient helpe and assistance from the
 Inhabitants there, as he shall think sufficient for the repairing clearing amending
 & making the aforesaid roads, passable both for horse Cart and foot,
 and whatge Charge may accrue thereby, the same to be payd & allowed out
 of the fines & forfeitures as shall be layd or imposed upon any person by the Court.

 for my proper use & behoof, & thereupon in my name to give Receipts or
 other discharges whatsoever Ratifying & Confirming whatsoever my
 said Attorney, shall doe or cause to be done in & about the premisses in as
 full and ample manner to all intents and purposes as if I my selfe
 were personally present at the acting & doing thereof In witnessse
