This Indenture made the Eleaventh day of August Anno Domini 1686 And in the second year of Our Sovereigne Lord James the Second by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King Defender of the faith &c Betweene Robert Burman of Maryland at present in London Merchant of the one part, and James Dryden of London Merchant of the other part Wittnesseth That the said Robert Burman for and in consideracion of the sum of five Skillings of Lawfull money of England to him in hand paid by the said James Dryden att and Before the ensealing and delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the said Robert Burman doth hereby acknowledge, and himselfe to be therewith fully satisfied and paid Bath for him his Heires Executors and Administrators given granted aliened Bargained sold enfeoffed & Confirmed And by these presents doth fully, cleerly, and absolutely give grant alien Bargaine Sell enfeoffe & confirme unto the said James Dryden his Heires & Assigines All that parcell or Tract of Land containing one hundred and twenty Acres more or lesse formerly laid out for Willd Batten and Thomas Thomas Mencioned to be conveyed to the said Robert Burman by Charles Gorsuch of Baltimore County in the Province of Maryland planter by deed bearing date the Second day of June Anno Domini 1685: and entered on Record in Baltimore County aforesaid June Anno Domini 1685: Libro E fol. 191: and alsoe all that parcell or Tract of Land called the Cross formerly laid out by Andrew Skinner deputy Surveyor for Warner Shudall mencioned to be conveyed to the said Robert Burman by Thomas Scudamore as Attorney of John Shudall by deed bearing date the six & twentieth of February 1684: and entered on Record in Baltimore County aforesaid Libro E fol. 147: Anno 1685: Togethe with all and singuler the Rights Members Jurisdiccons priviledges Issues Rents profits Benefits mesnages houses Edifices Buildings goods Household goods Crop or Crops Timber and Timber trees wayes passages Woods or Underwoods fences orchards Gardene comodities and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said two severall parcells or Tracts of Lands & either of them now belonging and appertaining or hereafter to belong or apperteine to the same, or either of them with all manner of Improvmt & Increase of servants & cattle And all & every the plantacions lands Tenementes & Hereditam<sup>t</sup> in Maryland by the said Robert Burman purchased of the said Charles Gorsuch Thomas Scudamore & John Shudall or any or either of them And all the estate Right Title Inheritance claime & demand whtsoever of him the said Robert Burman in & to the same, with all deeds Writings Patents Evidences Chirographies of ffrs Exemplificationes of Recories & Boundaries touching or concerning the said two parcells or Tracts of Land & premises or any part thereof Togethe alsoe with all the servants Horses Hogs & cattle named & mentioned in the Inventory herunto annexed Which said two severall parcells or Tracts of Land are situate lying & being on the North side of Potapsco River in the County of Baltimore and are now in the tenure or occupacion of the said Robert Burman To have and to hold the said Two severall parcells or Tracts of Land and all &
