This Indenture made the Seventeenth day of November in the third year of
the Raigne of our Sovereigne Lord James the Second by the grace of God of
England Scotland France and Ireland King defender of the faith &c. And in
the year of Lord God one thousand six hundred eighty & seaven Betwene
William o' Donell of Letter mullan in the County of Gallway and Kingdome
of Ireland gent. Sale Brother & heire of Morris o' Donell of Fair County in
the Province of Maryland gent. deceased of the one parte and Christopher
Mason of the Towhe of Gallway in the Kingdome of Ireland Merchant of
the other part Wittnesseth that the said o' Donell for and in consideracion of
the sum of Six Pounds ten Shillings sterl^t to him in hand paid before the
sealing and deliverie of these presents by the said Christopher Mason the
receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof doth acquitt and
discharge the said Christopher his Heires Executors & Administrators given
granted Bargained sold Enfeoffed released and confirmed And by these presents
he the said William o' Donell doth give grant Bargaine enfeoffe release &
confirme unto the said Christopher Mason in his actuall possession now
Being by vertue of a Bargaine & sale therof to him made by the said William
o' Donell for one whole year by Deed bearing date the day before the date of
these presents All that & those the severall houses Lands tenements & hereditam^t
and plantacions in the Province of Maryland enjoyed or purchased by the sd.
morris o' Donell containing three hundred Acres proffitable Land plantacion
measure bee the same more or leesse as alsoe three hundred & seaventeen Acres in
the Territory of Pensalvenia purchased by the said Morris To Have and to hold
unto the said Christopher Mason his heires and aspignes for ever the said severall
Lands in Maryland & Pensalvenia to the sole and onely use Benefitt and behoofe
of the said Christopher and his aspignes for ever And the said William o' Donell
doth for himself his heires Executors Administrators & Aspignes Covenant promise
grant & agree to & with the said Christopher Mason his heires and aspignes that he
the said William is sole brother & heire of the said Morris o' Donell And that he
the said William o' Donell and all persons deriveing from and under the said
morris shall & will from tyme to tyme and at all tymes hereafter doe make
suffer & execute or cause or suffer to be made done & Executed unto the said
Christopher Mason his heires & aspignes such & soe many further & other assurances
& assurances Conveyance & Conveyances of the premises be the same by any
one or more fine or fines Common recoverie or recoveries or by any other matter
of fact or record or both as by the said Christopher Mason his heires or aspignes
