 the moytie of the land to the same belonging to the use of the said Henry Lowe and
 Susanna his wife for their lives and the life of the longer liver of them and after both their
 deceases to the use of the Right Heires of the said Henry Lowe for ever And as for the
 said Tracts of land called Greenes Oak, Holdmanstone, Southward, Uriesley and
 Bennetts Hope to the use of the Heires of the said Henry Lowe on the body of the said
 Susanna Begotten and for want of such issue And as to all other the said hereby
 Graunted or mentioned to be graunted premises and every part and parcell of the
 same with the Appurtenances to the onely proper use and behoofe of the said Henry
 Lowe and of his Heires and Assignes absolutely and for ever and to and for none other
 use intent or purpose whatsoever In Witness whereof the parties aforesaid to these
 Indentures interchangeably have put their Hands and seals the day and year first
 above written.
