This Indenture made the sixth day of February in the Thirteenth Year of the Dominion of the Right honourable Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c: And in the yeare of our Lord god one Thousand Six Hundred Eighty and Seven. Betweene Coll Henry Towles of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland gent of the one pte and John Abington of the County & Province aforesaid gent of the other pte Witneseth That the said Henry Towles as well for and Inconsideration of the sume of Three Hundred & Twenty Pounds Two Shillings & five pence halfpenny of good & lawfull money of England
