then & there free & cleere from all Charges whatsoever without fraud
Coven or further delay That then & from thenceforth this present Indenture
of bargain & sale or Base Mortgage shall cease determine and be utterly
void frustrate to all intents & purposes whatsoever, otherwise shall stand &
remaine in full power force strength & vertue **AND** the said Henry Towles
for himselfe his Heires Executors Adm^{rs} doth Covenant promise & grant to
& with the said John Abington, his heires Execut^{rs} & Adm^{rs} and to and with
every of them by these presents That he the said Henry Towles his Heires
Executors Adm^{rs} or assignes or some or one of them shall & will at or before
the fourth day of June now next Ensueing the date hereof well & truly
pay or cause to be paid to the said John Abington, or to his certaine Attorney
his Executors Adm^{rs} or assignes at the place of payment aforesaid the said
summe of Three Hundred & Twenty pounds Two Skillings & five pence
half pency of good & lawfull money of England And alsoe the summe
of Tene Thousand seven hundred Twenty & Two pounds of such Tobacco
And in such manner & forme as in the proviso or Condition hereof is
Contained without making default in either of the said payments **AND**
if it shall happen that default of payment of either of the said summes
of money or Tobacco at the day's and places aforesaid be made contrary
