This Indenture made the One and Twentieth Day of March in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Six Hundred Eighty and Eight Between Charles Calvert of St. Maries County in the Province of Maryland Esquire Sonne & Heire of William Calvert Esquire dec<sup>d</sup> on the one Part, and William Arbuckle of Glasgow in Scotland now Resident in Maryland Merchant on the other part Witnesseth That the said Charles Calvert for and in Consideracion of the sume of five and Twenty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco to him in hand paid, and before the Ensealing hereof by the said William Arbuckle, the Receipt whereof the said Charles Calvert doth hereby acknowledge accordingly, and himself to be thereof and therewith fully satisfied and thereof, and of every part thereof doth clearly acquitt Exonorate and discharge the said William Arbuckle his Heires Ex<sup>s</sup> & Adm<sup>r</sup>, and every of them for ever by these Presents hath Granted, Bargained, Sold, Aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed, and by these Presents doth fully clearely and absolutely Graunt, Bargaine, Sell, Alien, Enfeoff and Confirme unto the said William Arbuckle & his Heires All those Two Plantacions Tracts or parcels of Land formerly graunted by the said William Calvert deceased to Daniell Devine and Hugh Manuing lying in the Mannes of St. Gabriells in the said County of St. Maries Commonly now or heretofore called & knowne by the name of Henry James Neck Containing Two hundred acres more or lesse, Beginning at a Marked Pine which is a corner tree parting a Plantacion formerly William Breene called Langfords Neck from the said Henry James Neck and soe Runneth to another Marked Pine, which standeth at the head of a little Rym, which parteth the said Bargained Land from the Land late of the said William Calvert deceased, which said Two hundred acres of Land were divided built and Seated on, by the said Daniell Devine & Hugh Manuing, Butt afterwards by both of them upon Exchange for other Land delivered up to the said William Calvert againe and all Mesnages Gementes Houses Out houses, Tobacco houses, and all other Dificies<sup>s</sup> Buildings, to the said Two hundred acres of Land Belonging or in any wise apperteining, and all wayes Easements woods Underwoods, proffitts Comodities and Appurtenances to the same belonging AND also a Pitt or little Neck of Land that lyes betweene Richard Calverts Land, and the Land hereby graunted, wheron the said Daniell Devine lived and all wayes, Easements, Woods Underwoods proffitts Comodities & Appurtenances to the same belonging which Containeth about Thirty acres, be the same belonging
