This Indenture made the Twentieth day of March in the eleventh year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Charles Baron of Baltimore absolute Lord and Proprietor of the provinces of Maryland and Carolina and Province of Virginia and eighty five Between William Whittington of Accomack in the County of Virginia Gent and Robert his wife of the one part and Robert Doyne of Charles County in the province of Maryland Gent on the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pound then paid to the said Robert Doyne by the said William Whittington and Robert his wife paid in hand and before the signing hereof by the said Robert Doyne the receipt whereof they do here by acknowledged and thereof accordingly and lawfully therewith and there to be fully satisfied and thereof and of every part thereof do fully & clearly acquit — acquit and discharge the said Robert Doyne his heirs Executors and Assignes and every of them for ever by their specialties they the said William Whittington and Robert his wife have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by their specialties for them and their heirs do fully & clearly absolutely granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto the said Robert Doyne and his heirs all that part or parcel of Land containing by Admision Six hundred acres of Land situate in the County of Stafford being and being in Charles County on the north side of Potomack river a water course called King's Creek or upon river and beginning at a marked oak standing north of a branch called A Shadons branch bounded according to patent on the West with the said Avar river and running to a branch called Shadons branch and to the head of the same to a marked oak on the east with the said Shadons branch, on the north with a line drawn from the head of Shadons branch for up length of Six hundred poles and from thence by a line drawn north until it shall intersect a parallel drawn from the head of A Shadons branch and which said Six hundred acres of Land whatsoever built and bounded is and is here by declared to be the Six hundred acres of Land surveyed and layd out by the name of Canamy Indian Town by Mr. Edmund Hall the Eighteenth day of November last by virtue of an order of his said Majesty's Council dated the eight and twentieth day of October last and now last past of return of which survey under the hand of the said Edmund Hall dated the Eighteenth day of November remains upon Record my said office of the province and layd out for Six hundred acres of Land and all woods underwoods timber and timber trees ways easements profits commodities and appurtenances what soever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and also of what right this interest use possession and remainder Reversion and Demand whatsoever of them the said William Whittington and Robert his wife of us
