

This Indenture made the tenth day of October in the third year of the
 Reigne of our Soueraigne Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary que
 England Dec^r Anno d^r 1691 Betweene William Price of Leaile County
 in the Province of Maryland gent of the one part and Nicholas Spourne of
 Calvert County in the Province afo^r Merchant of the other part witnesseth
 That the said William Price for and in Consideracion of the sum of fourty pounds
 of Lawfull mony of England to him in hand before the Ensealing and Delivery hereof
 well and truly satisfied and paid the receipt whereof the said William Price hath
 hereby acknowledge and him the said Nicholas Spourne his heires Execut^r and
 Administrat^r doth hereby of and from the same for ever acquitt and discharge
 Hath given granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presentes doth give
 grant Bargaine Sell & Confirme unto the said Nicholas Spourne his heires and
 Assignes for ever **All** That tract or parcell of Land commonly called or knowne
 by the name of Limes Venture That is to say what is in the possession of the
 William Price being one full halfe part or moity of the same Land situate
 Lying and being in the County of Calvert aforesaid and in a River of the said County
 and on the North side of the said River Beginning at a marked Gunn standing upon
 a point by a marsh in the said River and running for breadth down the said River
 a point by a low side bounding on the said Gunn by a line drawn North & by East for
 length in the woods five hundred thirty three perches and one third part of a
 perch bounding on the North East by a line drawn West by North severall perches
 bounding on the West by North by a line South by West unto the first bounded tree
 containing two hundred and fifty Acres more or less Together with all houses
 buildings barns tobacco houses fencings emoluments and other the premisses therunto
 belonging and to the said Tract of Land apperteyning **To have & to hold**
 the aforesaid Moity or halfe part of the afo^r Tract of Land and other the premisses therunto
 hereby granted bargained sold or meant mentioned or intended to be here by granted
 bargained and sold unto him the said Nicholas Spourne his heires &c Administrat^r
 for ever To the only proper use and behoofe of him the said Nicholas Spourne his
 heires and Assignes for ever more And to no other use intent or purpose what soeuer
 And the said William Price for himself his heires Execut^r Administrat^r doth
 hereby Covenant promise and graunt to and with the said Nicholas Spourne
 his heires and Assignes That the aforesaid Moity or Tract of Land shall be and
 remaine unto the said Nicholas Spourne his heires & Assignes for ever free & clear
 of and from all manner of incumbrances what soeuer hereby warranting and
 deferring the same of and from all manner of persons what soeuer claiming or to
 claime any right title or interest to the Moity or halfe part of the land afo^r
 And the said William Price Doth further for himself his heires &c Administrat^r
 further Covenant and graunt to and with the said Nicholas Spourne his heires &
 Assignes that he the said William Price shall & will from time to time and at
 all times here after at resonable request and at the proper cost and charges of
 the said Nicholas Spourne his heires or assignes make such further or other
 assurance or Assurances of the afo^r land by way of conveyance fine or
 recovery or by any other wayes or meanes for the more sure making or
 conveying the same to him the said Nicholas Spourne his heires or assignes as
 he or they shall be resonably aduised by Councill in law In witness whereof
 the said William Price have hereunto sett his hand and seale the day & year
 aforesaid
