

To all People To whom these presents shall come Wee the Comm^{rs} for managing and causing to be levied and collected their Maj^{ties} Customs Subsidies and other Duties in their Kingdom of England send greeting Know yee that wee the said Commissioners by Vertue of an Act of Parliament Made in the 25th yeare of King Charles the Second Beigne Entituled an Act for the Encouragement of the East Land and Greenland Trades and for better Securing the Plantacon Trade and p^{ro}vision of the Authority and Direction to us given by the R^{ts} Hon^{ble} the Lords Comm^{rs} of their Maj^{ties} Treasury HALL Deputed and Impowred and Doe here by Depute and Impower Edward Randolph Esq. to be Surveyor Generall of the Rates and Duties arising and growing due to their Maj^{ties} by Vertue of the said Act in their Maj^{ties} severall Colonys upon the Coast of America And he is hereby also appointed to Inspect the Actions of the Collectors and other officers Employed in and about the Managing and Collecting of the aforesaid Duties and to Examine their Books and accounts And hath also power to Enter into any Shipp Bottom Boat or other Vessel as also into any Shoppe House Warehouse Hostery or other place what soever to make Diligent Search into any Trunk Chest Cask Case Truss or any other parcell or Package what soever for any Goods wares or Merchandizes Prohibited to be Imported or Exported or Where of the Customs or other Duties have Not been duly paid and the same to seize to their Maj^{ties} use and also to putt in Execution all other the Law full powers and Authorities for the better Managing or Collecting the said Duties in all things proceeding as the Law Directs; Hereby praying and requiring all and every their Maj^{ties} officers and Ministers and all others whom it may concerne to be Aiding and assisting to Him in all things as becometh Given under our hands and Seal at the Custome house London this 14th day of October in the third yeare of the Reigne of our Soueraigne Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary King of Dorn: 1691:
