Memorand It is agreed between the said parties That the said William Price his wife is to wash and mend the clothes of the servants of the said Hewellin during the term of the said Hewellin finding soape for the same, for which the said Price's wife is to have the liberty of ground upon the said plantation for planting of some Tobacco or other severall Necessaries also to raise Poultry upon the same for her owne use

This Indenture made the second day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred ninety and one Betweene Charles Calvert of Maryland County in the province of Maryland Esq^r and Henry Denton of the same County Gent on the one part and Charles Egerton of St. Marys County aforesaid Gent on the other part Witnesseth that where as the Right hon^{ble} Charles Lord Baltimore by his said patent bearing date the sixteenth day of September Anno Domini 1688 for the consideration therein mentioned did graunt unto the said Henry Denton All that tract or parcell of land called Seabergnam lying in Talbot County upon the north side of the north east branch of great Choptank river beginning at an history mark with the two also notted by the quarter third the lowest notted on two opposite quarters standing on equal height with the highest notted on the two other quarters lying history stands under the bank of the river a little below the uppermost bar and from thence run over to the road to Doldward bay passed before it crossed the river and from that history it runs north west over the said road by an history and the said mark with the two notted three hundred and twenty pented and from the end of that north west line it runs north east four hundred pented to intersect a line drawn drawn north west three hundred and twenty pented from a small red oak mark at aforesaid standing by a little branch a bow half a mile above the flood of Doldward road and from the said oak run down the river to the said history bearing south west on the south east bounded by the river continuing and then layd out for eight hundred rods with the adjacent shoamp vallies and marshes of the river to the said oak and history bearing south west or to have and to hold the said unto the said Henry Denton his heirs and assigns forever And where as the said Charles Lord Baltimore by his said patent also bearing date the eighteenth day of the said month of September 1688 for the consideration therein mentioned did graunt unto the said Henry Denton All that tract or parcell of land called Flowdoul lying in Talbot County on the south side of the Choptank river and on a branch of the said river called Flowdoul beginning at a marked oak standing on the north line of a parcel of land formerly layd out for William Bishop called Bishop's field and running north west with the west side of two parcels to
