

This Ind^r. made the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand six
 hundred Ninety and one between Garrett Banfroingen of the city of St. Maries in the
 province of Maryland gent and Catharia Banfroingen som and heire apparent of the
 said Garrett and Iames Pattison of St. Maries County in the province aforesaid hont on his one
 part and Edward Greenhalgh of the same County merchant on his other part witnesseth
 that for and in consideration of the summe of Eleaven thousand pounds of Cobars to his said
 Catharia Banfroingen in hand paid at and before the underscoring hereof by this said -
 Edward Greenhalgh the receipt wherof his said Catharia doth hereby acknowledge
 and himselfe to be thys of and therewith fully satisfied and thys of and of debte part
 thys of deth clearly acq[ui]t, exonerate and discharge the said Edward Greenhalgh his
 heires executors and adms and every of them for ever by these presents and of the summe of one
 shilling sterl[ing] money of England to his said Garrett Banfroingen in hand also payed
 by the said Edward Greenhalgh before the underscoring h[er]e of the receipt wherof is
 hereby acknowledged accordingly that the said Garrett Banfroingen and Catharia
 Banfroingen have graunted bargained aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these
 presents doth fully clearly and absolutely graunt Bargaunderlyng enfeoffed and confirmed
 unto the said Edward Greenhalgh his heires and assignes for ever all that part or
 partell of land lying in St. Maries County aforesaid and part of a manor called S.
 Elizabeth manor formerly graunted unto Thomas Cornewall Esq^r by letter
 patents under the great seal of this province afterwards by madam Cornewall
 to herne the Estate of Walter Hall decessed and this tract hereby intended to be recovered
 and to be sold by Walter Hall and Margaret his wife unto the said Garrett Banfroingen
 White said tract or partell of land beginning at the stony run be yond the thurz running
 up the north east branch of this said run to the exterior line of S. Elizabeth manor
 aforesaid thence running north west to a bounded Spanish oak being one of the
 bound trees of the said manor thence running west to a bounded white oak standing at the
 head of S. Jimis and so running a long th[is] road to the aforesaid stony run continuing by
 estimation sev[n]en hundred acres be the same more or less together with the plantation
 and house outhouſed garden or eards baraco stables and buildings thereto belonging
 together with all woods trees and timber freehold rights priviledges benefits and appurtenances
 to the said bargained land belonging or in any manner of way apperteyning except
 and alwayes reserved out of this present graunt fifty acres of land lying and begining at
 the bounded white oak of Thomas Lole and John Baker lands and so running straight
 a long th[is] road to the boun[d] tree of this land lastly sold to the said Garrett
 and Catharia had already sold and promised to convey unto Elizabeth Baker widow
 lyod adjoyning to a partell of land upon her late husbands land thys and that
 named Pattison for the consideration of one shilling sterl[ing] to him in hand payed by
 the said Edward Greenhalgh the receipt wherof his said Esq^r acknowledged accordingly
 By the direction and request of the said Garrett & Catharia Banfroingen have graunted
 bargained sold enfeoffed aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth graunt
 Bargaine sell alien enfeoffe sold and confirmed unto the said Edward Greenhalgh
 and his heires and assignes All that the aforesaid land and bargained premises except
 the fifty acres before excepted and the quiet contens to the lord of the fee of S. Elizabeth
 manor to have and to hold the said land plantation houses and all other the premises
 hereby bargained and sold with theire and dodye of their appurtenances except before
 excepted onto the said Edward Greenhalgh his heires and assignes to him onely proper
 ty and behoofe of the said Edward Greenhalgh his heires and assignes for ever under
 the rents and service due and accustomed to the manor of S. Elizabeth this abovesayd
 land the said Garrett Banfroingen and Catharia Banfroingen the said land and
 premises with the appurtenances (except before excepted) unto the said Edward Greenhalgh
 and his heires against all people shall and will warrant for ever defend by these
 presents and the said Garrett & Catharia Banfroingen for him and his
 executors and administrators jointly & severally doth toenant graunt and agree to and
 with the said Edward Greenhalgh his heires and assignes in manner & forme following
 (that is to say) that they the said Garrett & Catharia Banfroingen and family
