 John Evans his heirs and assigns for ever All that tract or parcel of land
 called Brushy work in St. Marys County Beginning at popes hogpen in a
 run and running by the maine brant joyning upon the land now or late in the
 possession of Nicholas Guy the said John Evans and the said Anthony and Jane
 woods and from popes hogpen by the bay to the land of Stomhops Roberts called
 Drapers work and from the head of popes hogpen run with a line drawn North
 on the north of Brushy work to Stomhops Roberts land being part of office
 thousand seven hundred acres formerly granted unto William Hawley Esq.
 detached and severed unto William Guy the said Anthony and Jane
 and assigns for ever By a decree out of the high Court of Chancery of the
 province of Virginia said tract called Brushy work as aforesaid was afterwards
 purchased by one John Halfhead of St. Marys County Gent to him and his heirs
 for ever from the said William Guy the said Anthony and Jane upon the date of the
 said John Halfhead without his estate unto the Right hon. Charles Lord
 Baltimore Proprietary of this province do by a certain Acquisition indenture
 bearing date the 12th day of August An. Dom 1678 relation being hereto
 had it doth and may appear did afterwards by Letter patent under the great
 seal of this province bearing date the 30th day of May 1679 for the said
 reasons and considerations therein mentioned granted unto Henry Elliot late
 of St. Marys County Gent and Jane his wife now party to this present Ind.
 his heirs and assigns for ever and now vested in the said Anthony and Jane
 containing by Estimation three hundred acres and by Certificate of Survey of
 the said 5700 acres mentioned Be it now or hereafter to hold all and
 singular the aforesaid tract or parcel of land premises together with all lands
 outwards tobacco hump orchards gardenes and plantations with all the appurtenances
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Anthony
 Evans his heirs and assigns for ever to the use intents and purposes therein
 mentioned expressed and to none other use intent or purpose whatsoever that is
 to say to the use of the said Anthony and Jane his wife during their small lives
 and the remainder to the use of the said Anthony and Jane his heirs and assigns for ever
 and to none other use intent or purpose whatsoever In witness whereof the said
 Anthony and Jane have hereunto put their hands and seals the day and year
 first above written.
