This Indenture made the 17th day of September 1692:
Between George Thompson of s^t Maries County in the Province
of Maryland Gent of the one part and Barnabie Ancketill of the s^t
County & Province Gent of the other part Witnesseth that the s^t
George Thompson for and in consideration of two parcels of
Land (the one called Ancketill formerly laid out for five hundred
acres of Land but upon Resurvey found to be but four hundred
and forty acres of Land, the other parcell called Ancketills Range
containing fifty acres of Land in both parcells being but four
hundred & ninety acres of Land which parcells of Land are on the
East side of Chesapeake Bay in Talbot County on the North side of
Choptank River and in Harriess Creeke and Ancketills Range Joyned
upon Mr John Andertons Land to him the said Thomson sold & delivered
and Conveyed for them drawne and delivered with Turfe & Trigg upon
the same by the said Barnabie Ancketill from him his heires Ex^{ts}
Adm^{rs} and Assignes for ever unto the said George Thompson his heires Ex^{ts}
Adm^{rs} and Assignes for ever where with the said George Thompson doth
hereby Acknowledge himselfe therewith fully satisfied Contented & paid
and therby fully Cleerly & Absolutely Acquitt Discharged Exonerate
and Release
