This Indenture made the 17th day of September A^c 1692: -
 Between George Thompson of St^t Maries County in the Province
 of Maryland gent of the one part and Barnabie Auckettill of the
 County of Maryland gent of the other part witnesseth that the
 George Thompson for and in consideration of two Parcolls of
 Land (the one called Auckettill formerly laid out for five hundred
 acres of land but upon Survey found to be but four hundred
 and forty acres of land, the other parcoll called Auckettills Range
 containing fifty acres of land in both parcells being but four
 hundred & Ninety acres of land which parolls of land are on the
 East side of Chesapeak Bay in Talbot County on the North side of
 Choptauke River and in Harrisches Creeke and Auckettills Range Joynes
 upon Mr John Andertons land to him the said Thompson should & delivered
 and Conveyed for them drawne and delivered with Turf & Tuigg upon
 the same by the said Barnabie Auckettill from him his heires Execut^{es}
 Adm^{ts} and Assignes for ever unto the said George Thompson his heires Ex^{es}
 Adm^{ts} and Assignes for ever where with the said George Thompson doth
 hereby acknowledge himself therewith fully satisfied Contented & paid
 and therby fully Cleary & Absolutely Acquit Discharged Exonorate
 and Release
