the fourth year of our Sovereign Lord & Lady King William
& Queen Mary & in the year of our Lord 1692. Between Mottram
Wright of the County of Lancaster Gent of the one part and Edward
Chilton of the County of Charles City Gent of the other part Witnesseth
That the said Mottram Wright for & in consideration of the sum of
Two hundred pounds Sterling Money of England to him in hand at
before the Sealing & Delivery of these presents by the sd Edward Chilton
well & truly paid the receipt whereof he the said Mottram Wright
doth here by Acknowledge & himself therewith fully satisfied & paid
the receipt & release of thereof & of Every part thereof doth clearly
acquit Exonerate & discharge the said Edward Chilton his heirs Ex^{ts}
& Dom^o for ever by these presents hath given granted aliened bargained
sold Enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents doth fully clearly
& absolutely give grant bargain sell alien Enfeoff & confirm
unto the said Edward Chilton his heirs & Assignes for ever, all that
Tract & parcell of Land called Bolton lying in the East side of the great
Bay on the North side of a River in the said Bay called the River
the Land called Turkey point Beginning at a marked stake by a Marsh
Side Near along Sandy point running for breadth down the River
Two hundred & ninety perches & by the Bay side Two hundred perches
Bounding on the East by a line drawn North & by east from the said stake
for length Three hundred & twenty perches on the North by a line drawn
West Southwest from the end of the North line into the said Bay
on the West with the said Bay, on the South with the said River
