By this publick Instrument of procreation or Letter of Attorney I doe knowe & manifest unto all people  
That on the six & twentieth day of the month of December Anno Domini one thousand six hundred & sixtie  
Seauen in the ninth & twentieth year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord Charles the second by the grace  
of God King of England Scotland France & Ireland Defender of the Faith &c before me William Scordy  
Notary & Cadethon publick by authority of our Sovereign Lord the King admitted & sworn  
dwelling in this City of London in the Church of the witneses after named personally appeared  
William Jurin of Christ church parish in the County of Surry, near London, Waterman Robert  
Jurin of the Parish of St Andrew Holbourn near London aforesaid, Drury lawyer Legats of together  
with Symon Jurin, & Jane Jurin als Marrott the wife of Henry Marrott of Walton in the County  
of Buckingham Sawyer merchant, as Brother & Sister in & by the last will & Testament of their  
Sister Elizabeth May als Jurin lately deceased in Maryland in parts beyond the Seas which appears  
for themselves & also for & in behalf of their said Sister Jane from whose said Husband as will  
as from her self the said William Jurin has order & power to receive & discharge, in  
reference to what herein after mentioned & also as representative with their said Sister Jane  
& Interstant with her of & in their said Brother Symon his part & share of the after mentioned Legacy  
her having been absent for the space of nine yeares now last past or thereabouts, & they appears not  
knowing or having had any News where he is, or whether he be living or dead, have made ordeined and  
in their steads & places have put constituted & by these presents doe make ordeain, & in their steads and places  
doe put & constitute Mr John Barrow of Maryland aforesaid - Giving unto him full power authority &  
spiritual charge for & in the names of them appears & of their said Sister, to take, demand, & receive,  
& receive of & from Mr Robert Curville of St Marys in Maryland aforesaid - Executor of the last  
will & Testament of the said Elizabeth May deceased or of his Heires, or goods where so ever they shall  
be found, or of such other person or persons whom it of right doth or may concern, a Legacy of  
four thousand pounds of Tobacco left as Legacy, (in & by the said Elizabeth May's last will)  
unto, and to be divided amongst them the said William, Robert, Symon, & Jane Jurin, or the  
Survivors of them: of the necessary receipt to make & give due acquittance & discharge And  
if need be in, about the premises, or any part thereof, for the Constituent to appear & their  
persons, in the capacity or capacities aforesaid to represent in all Courts & before all Lords Judges  
& Justices, & to doe, say, pursue, Implead, Levy, Sequester Attach, arrest, Imprison & to  
to remove out of prison again (when need shall be) to deliver likewise our Attorney or  
more with like or limited power under him to make & substitute & att his pleasure again to  
revoke. And generally in & concerning the premises & the dependents thereof to doe, say,  
transact & accomplish all & what so ever the said Constituent themselves acting as aforesaid,  
might or could doe personally, although the matter required more speciall authority than  
herein is comprized they the said Constituent here by promising to have & to hold, & trust to be  
had & hold for good firm & of Value for ever all & what so ever their said Attorney or his  
Substitutes shall lawfully doe or procure to be done in & about the premises by Virtue of
