Thereupon built and erected to them the said William Bent & Joseph Bullett their executors and assigns from the day of the date of these presents for and during the and to the full end and termes of four Score years from hence next ensuing and fully to compleat and ended, Together with free agerse and regresse to the said Water Mill either by land through through any mans Land next ad joining or else by water together with liberty to fell cut downe & carry away either by land or water any timber fit for building of the said Mill other then timber fit to spilt into Clapboards for and during the termes aforesaid, according to the true intent and meaning of the Act of Assembly Yelding and paying Yearly and every year during the said termes to William Barton of Charles County planter in the said Inquisition mentioned to bee the present possessor of the said Land his Ayres executors or Assignes the Rent or sume of one hundred & fifty pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco at some convenient place in Maryland aforesaid, In testimony whereof wee have caused the greatt Seal of our said Province to bee affixed to these presents Dated at our City of St. Marys and witness our Trusty and well beloved Lionell Copley Esq; our Capt Gen^l and Chife Governo^r of our said Province of Maryland this 13th day of February and in the 5th yeare of our Reigne anno^r Domini 1692: / L. Know all men by these presents that I Edward Middleton for divers good causes and consideracions me mouing have made ordained - deputed and Constituted by these presents do ordaine appoint and constitute my Louring friend Thomas Grunwin of the City of St. Marys my true & Lawfull attorney for me and in my Name & to the use behooffe & Benefit of Philip Lynes to acknowledge either before the Provinciall Court or two Justices of the same, or before the County Court of St. Marys County or two Justices therof qualified to take acknowledgement according to law one Deed - bearing date the 20th day of this instant feb^r made from the said Edward Middleton to the said Philip Lynes and his heires of one tract of Land lying and being in St. Marys County containing one hundred acres & is knowne & called by the name of Evans reserve & was by me bought of Edward Evans and that the same is my Deed and by me signed sealed and delivered, as my act and Deed to or to the use of the said Philip Lynes and his heires aforesaid for ever, and all other matters relating to the premises in order to the Reccording of the said Deed and sure making the said Land to the said Philip Lynes & his heires to act do & performe as fully and effectually as I myself might or could do personally holding for same all and whatsoever my attorney shall do or cause to be done by vertue hereof witness my hand and seal this 22nd day of February 1691:
