

with other conditions covenant and promises in the said Letter & Battalion  
 mentioned as by the same remaining upon Record in the same Province  
 of Maryland relation being therunto had, may more at large appear.  
 By vertue whereof the sd W<sup>m</sup> Smith became possessed of the sd land  
 and theron did erect and built divers houses and afterward dying  
 by his last Will and Testament in writing Legally pronounced Constituted  
 and appoint mary his wife his whole & sole Executrix who afterward  
 Intermarried with Daniell Jenifer of the City of Maryland gent and  
 dyed intestate. And whereas the sd Daniell became <sup>Administrator</sup> legally of all & singular  
 the goods & chattells of the sd William which were not administered by  
 the sd Mary Ex-<sup>es</sup> as aforesaid, and thereby became also legally possessed of all  
 and singular the premises. He the sd Daniell on the seventeenth day of  
 December in the year of our Lord God 1672. by a certaine writing  
 under his hand and seal for a valuable Consideration therin mentioned  
 to him paid did sell and make over the premises aforesaid with the appurte-  
 nances unto Garrett Vanpoerungen and John Quigley gent for the summe  
 aforesaid, and whereas also the said John Quigley did assigne sell & make over  
 unto the sd Garrett Vanpoerungen his Ex-<sup>es</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>s or Assigues all his the said  
 Quigley right titles and interest of in and to the premises and every part and  
 porcell thereof by Indenture of Assignment bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of  
 February in the year of our Lord God 1672. AND WHEREAS the said  
 Garrett Vanpoerungen for and in Consideration of the summe of Eighteen thousand  
 pounds of tobacco to him paid by the sd John Quigley did upon the 3<sup>d</sup> day  
 of February Anno Domini 1672. devise grant and to have lett unto the sd  
 Quigley his Ex-<sup>es</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>s or Assigues all those two Messuages or Tenements  
 being part of the premises aforesaid, the one then in the tenure possession and  
 occupation of Robert Kidgely and ther then in the tenure and possession  
 of Robert Crumle together with all the ground within the payles from  
 the Backside of the said house untill within twenty foot of the gutter  
 before the Doore of the house wherin the sd Garrett then lived the  
 Divisionall line to runne from the payles fronting toward the Country  
 house then in the possession of Richard Moy untill it comparrell with  
 the Kitchen Chimney then in the possession of m<sup>r</sup> John Moorcraft and  
 so with a straight lyne to the sd Kitchen Chimney To have & to hold the  
 sd Tenements & premises part of the sd first devised premises to him  
 the sd John Quigley his Ex-<sup>es</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>s or Assigues until the end of the  
 bearing aforesaid granted by the sd Lord Baltimore to the sd William Smith  
 Yelding and paying therfore yearly unto the sd Garrett his Ex-<sup>es</sup>  
 Adm<sup>r</sup>s or Assigues at the house wheron he then lived one shill<sup>c</sup> easson  
 at or upon the feaste of the birth of the our Lord God in every respective  
 year if demanded. AND WHEREAS also the sd John Quigley for and  
 in Consideration of the summe of sixteen thousand pounds of tobacco  
 to him paid by Marke Cordea gent hath assigned his Right & title  
 of in and to the sd two Messuages or Tenements with the appurtenances  
 for and during the remainder of the sd terme of one & thirty years  
 then to come and undevyred in the premises to the sd Marke Cordea his  
 Ex-<sup>es</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>s or Assigues as by Indenture of William Calvert the  
 Attorney of the sd John Quigley under his hand and seal bearing date the  
 29<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1673. on the back of the sd Indenture of  
 assignment from the sd Garrett to the sd John Quigley doth may appear
