 causes and Considerations him therunto mooving by a certain writing
 or Instrument under his hand and seal bearing date the 29th of July
 1673: hath also remised, releas'd and for ever quite clayme unto the
sd Mark Cordca his Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} & Assignes his full & p^{ro}portable possession
 & Sojrin for and during the remaind of the tearme of years affd
 then to come and ^{un}expired in the p^{ro}mises all such right title Interest
 & demand as the sd Garrett then had or ought to have of in or to all
 the sd two messuages or Tenements with the Land therunto
 belonging according to the Divisionall bound affd, by any waies or
 means what soever (excepted the sd yearly rent of one Shilling
 which he reserved to be paid him every yeare at Christmas affd, by
 the sd Mark Cordca his Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} or Assignes in forme affd,
 To have & to hold the sd two messuages or Tenements with the
 appurtenances unto him the sd Mark Cordca his Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs}
 to the only use & behoofe of the sd Mark Cordca his Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} & Assignes
 for and during the remaind of the sd tearme of sd thirty years
 under the yearly rent affd, AND Whereas the sd Mark Cordca
 by Indenture under his hand & seal bearing date the 10th day of
 October in the yeare of our Lord God 1685: for and in Consideration
 of the sume of Sixteen thousand pounds of Tobacco to him paid
 by William Digges did grant bargain sell assigne and sett over unto
 the sd Wm Digges his Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} & Assignes the sd two Messuages
 or Tenements with all and singular the Lands and appurtenances
 therunto belonging and all other the p^{ro}mises or mentioned to be
 demised and granted by the sd Garrett Hansweringen to the sd John
 Quigley and by the sd John Quigley to the sd Mark Cordca and by the
 said Mark Cordca to the sd William Digges in and by the sd Indentures or
 Deeds Indented and Assignm^{ts} before recited, particularly expressed
 meeted and bounded To have & to hold the sd Messuages or Tenem^{ts}
 Lands and p^{ro}mises with all and singular their appurtenances before
 expressed to him the sd William Digges his Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} or Assignes
 from the day of the date of the sd last recited Indenture from the sd
 Mark Cordca to the sd Wm Digges for and during the rest & residue
 of the sd tearme of sd thirty years then yet to come and ^{un}expired
 and Whereas the sd William Digges hath since received a promise or
 assurance from the sd Hon^{ble} Charles Lord Baltimore for the
 Reversion of the sd two messuages or Tenements with the appurtenances
 Lands and p^{ro}mises granted by the sd Mark Cordca to the sd William
 Digges) to be granted to him the sd Wm Digges his heirs & Assignes
 for ever AND further Whereas Francis Bennington of s^{td}
 Maries County Gent having taken up a certaine Lot of Land situate
 lying and being in the City of Towne and Port of s^{td} Maries Marke
 Noted & knowne by the Number (43) & duly entered the same with
 the Clarke of the sd Towne and having also built thereon a Twenty
 ffoote house in pursuance and according to the directions of a certain
 Act of Assembly of this Province Intituled (an Act for Advancement
 of Trade) AND Whereas also the sd William Digges having taken up
 a certaine other Lot situate in the sd Towne or Port of s^{td} Maries
 marked & knowne by the Number (44) and hat duly entered
 the same with the Clarke affd, both which sd Lots were part or
 part of a greater tract of Land granted by the sd Coultius Lord
 Baltimore to him the sd Francis Bennington his heirs & Assignes
 for ever
