Executrix of the last Will and Testament of Thomas Cornwallis late of Burnham  
thorp in the County of Norfolk Esq; deceased of the one part and Edward Eye of  
Charles County in the Province of Maryland Esq; of the other part witnesseth  
That the said Penelope Cornwallis for and in Consideration of the summe of  
five Shillings of Lawfull money of England to her in hand paid before this  
onfoaling hore of by (the sd Edward Eye) the receipt whereof is hereby ac  
knowledege accordingly hath bargained sold and Demised and by these  
presente doth bargaine sell and Demise unto the sd Edward Eye All That  
Tract of Land lying on the east side of Liscaway River situate Lying and  
being in the sd Province of Maryland in the parts beyond the seas called by  
the name of Mattawoman Neck or by what soever other Name or Names  
the same is or heretofore hath beene Called or knowne Begining at a  
marked Ash tree in a swampe in or neare a Indian Towne running therethrough  
into the Woods nine hundred & Sixty yds, on the East by a south east line  
thence on the South with a line drawn west from the end of the sd Southeast  
line in a fresh Runn of a great Creek called St Thomas Creek and with  
the sd Fresh Runn and Creek, on the West with the River for the length of  
one hundred & fifty yds on the North with the River for the length of one  
Thousand six hundred yds conteyning and laid out for three thousand acres  
more or lesse all which premises are now in the possession of the Indians  
And also all the Estate Right, Tith, Intercess, Claimes & Demand of her the  
sd Penelope Cornwallis of in or to the premises or any part thereof to have  
and to hold the sd Tract of Land and all and singular other the premises  
& dury of their appurtenances unto the said Edward Eye his executors  
and Assignes from the day before the day of the date hereof unto the end  
Term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be  
complete and ended Yelding and paying therfore the rent of One pound  
sterling at the feast of the nativity of S: John Baptiste next ensuing (if  
the same be lawfully demanded) To the intent that by vertue of these  
presente and of the Statute for transferring uses into possession The said  
Edward Eye may be in the actuall possession of the premises and thereby  
enabled to accept a grant of the possession and inheritance therof to him  
& his heirs to bes to be declared In witness whereof the parties  
as to the Indentures Interchangeably haue put their hands & seals the  
day and yeaer first above written
