

This Indenture made the Twentieth day of October Anne Anno Domini 1688
 And in the fourth yeare of the Raigne of our Souerain Lord James the Second by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King defend of the Faith & Betweene Bondope Cornwallis
 Widow wch sole Executrix of the last Will & Testament of Thomas Cornwallis late of Burnham Thorpe in the County of Norfolk Esq;
 Deceased of the one part and Edward Eye of Charles County in the
 Province of Maryland Esq; of the other part witnesseth that the sd
 Bondope Cornwallis for and in Consideration of the summe of Seventy
 two pounds of Lawfull Money of England to her in hand paid at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the sd Edward Eye
 the receipt whereof the sd Bondope Cornwallis doth hereby acknow-
 ledge and her selfe to be therof and therewith fully satisfied and thereof
 and every part & parcell therof doth clearly acquite exonerate and
 discharge the said Edward Eye his heires Ex-Heires and every of them
 for dues by these presents hath granted bargained sold released & confirmed
 Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release & confirm unto the sd Edward Eye his actuall possession & sovrin now being by & of a
 date the day before the date hereof made or mentioned to be made between
 the sd Bondope Cornwallis of the one part and the sd Edward Eye of the
 other part and by force of the Statute for transferring uses into
 possession in that behalfe made & provided and to his heires All that
 Tract of Land lying on the East side of Piscataway River situate
 Lyning and being in the said Province of Maryland in the parts
 beyond the seas called by the name of Mattawoman Neck or by whatsoeuer
 name or names the same is or hath bin heretofore called or known
 Beginning at a marked Ash tree in a swamp in or neare an Indian
 Towne running into the woods Nine hundred and Sixty acres on the
 East by a South east line thence on the South with a line drawn west from
 the end of the said South east line in a south runn of a great Creek called
 St. Thomas Creek and with the sd Creek running and crooke on the west
 to the sd River for the length of one hundred & fifty yds on the North with
 the River for the length of one thousand six hundred yds containing and
 laid out for three thousand acres more or less all which promises are
 now in the possession of the Indians and also all the estate right title or
 interest in horitance heuision claims and demand what soever of or
 with the appurtenances and every part and parcell therof TO HAVE
 & TO HOLD the sd plantation or Tract of Land and all and singular other
 the promises with their and dudry of their appurtenances unto the sd
 Edward Eye his heires and assigns to only use & boosome of the sd Edward
 Eye his heires and assigns for ever and thence to the sd Bondope
 Cornwallis & her heires the sd Tract of Land and all and singular other
 promises unto the sd Edward Eye his heires & assigns against all persons
 law fully claiming any estate or demand into or out of the sd promises
 (other then against one William Hollings worth deuised & his heires by
 whom the promises were formerly mortgaged for two hundred and five
 pounds unto Thomas Conwallis also deuised & against the sd Indians) shall
 will warrant and defend for ever by these presents and the sd Bondope
 Cornwallis doth hereby declare covenant and grant to & with the sd Edward
 Eye his heires and assigns That the said sume & with the
 and fiftioun pounds above mentioned to be laid upon the security of the
 promises (other then the sume of nine pounds for shillings per
 part therof)
