 levy and pass or cause & procure to be made done executed levied and
 passed all & every such further and other Act and Acts thing and things
 to be done and to be done Comyns and Assurances in the law whatsoever for
 the further better and more effect confirming & confirming of all
 and singular the premises with the appurtenances unto the ^{sd} Edward Bye
 his heires and Assignes and that by such wayes & means and in such
 manner & forms as by the ^{sd} Edward Bye his heires or Assignes or by his or
 their counsell learned in the laws shall be reasonably devised or advised and
 required so as the ^{sd} Dorothea Cornwallis or her heires or such other person
 or persons who shall be required by virtue hereof to make any further
 Assurances be not compelled for the doing thereof to travell from her
 or their respective dwelling houses or places of abode for the time being

 County in the ^{sd} Province of Maryland her true & lawfull attorney and
 assignee for her & in her name To acknowledge this her deed before the Right
 hon^{ble} the Lord Baltmore Governour of the ^{sd} Province of Maryland
 or before such other person or persons as doo usually take Cognizance of
 Deeds of lands in the ^{sd} Province of Maryland in order to the Enrolment
 of the same and that the ^{sd} Dorothea Cornwallis shall and will hold and
 allow for firme & effectually all and whatsoever her ^{sd} Attorney shall
 Lawfully doo or cause to be done by virtue hereof In Witness whereof
