of the other part amongst many other things therein contained may appear, And whereas the said  
John Addison hath already the Quantity & Number of one hundred Thousand & four Thousand & nine  
hundred pounds weight Neat good sound & merchantable leaf Tobacco of the proper Good & Merchandize  
of the said Thomas Addison in his own hand & Custody in Maryland aforesaid, It is therefore covenanted  
concluded & agreed upon by & betwixt the said parties to these presents and the said John Addison for himself  
his Exors & Adms: doth covenant & grant to & with the said Thomas Addison his Exors & Adms: that he the said  
John Addison his Exors or Assignes, shall well and  
truly pay & deliver or cause to be truly paid or delivered unto the said Thomas Addison his Exors  
Administrators Assignes the said one hundred Thousand & four Thousand & nine hundred pounds  
weight Neat good sound merchantable leaf Tobacco & Cash according to the Custom of Maryland aforesaid  
in manner following, that is to say Thirty four Thousand pounds weight Neat good sound  
merchantable leaf Tobacco to contain Eighty hogsheads or thereabouts all or before the death day of March  
next ensuing the date hereof or within forty dayes next after the first arrivall of the said Shipps at the  
Maryor River as aforesaid or which shall first come & happen there to be laden aboard the said Shipps  
and Security Thousand & nine hundred pounds weight Neat of like Tobacco & Cash the residue & remainder  
thereof before the death day of October which will be in the year of our Lord God one Thousand six hundred  
Seventy eight, And it is agreed by & betwixt the said parties to these presents that the said Thirty four  
Thousand pounds weight Neat sound merchantable leaf Tobacco shall be delivered to the said Thomas  
Addison his Exors Administrators & Assignes or Attorney at convenient place or places in the said  
River of Maryland, where sloopes may safely take in the same, to be put on board the said Shipps in case  
the arrivall thereof in bulke & Cask as may be thought convenient, to & for the account & proper use of the  
said Thomas Addison his Exors Administrators & Assignes, which said Tobacco shall be accounted  
according to the first weighing & Bunk Entry of the same any thing here in contained to the contrary  
notwithstanding, and the said Thomas Addison for himself his Exors & Administrators doth covenant  
promise & grant to & with the said John Addison his Exors Administrators or Assignes that he the said  
Thomas Addison his Exors Administrators shall & will pay or allow & discount to the said John  
Addison his Exors Administrators & Assignes all reasonable Costs & Charges that shall be Expended in  
Shipping the said Thirty four thousand pound weight Neat sound merchantable leaf Tobacco, & shall  
run all & square hazards of the same, by water fire & Enemies, & shall also pay & bear of all such  
monye as shall become due to the said Master at his returne his Exors Administrators or  
Assignes for Freight of the said Thirty four Thousand pound weight Neat Merchantable leaf Tobacco  
& Casks as aforesaid Reasonably & proportionably to the full Stowage & whole freight of the said Shipps  
& other demands of the said Master his Exors or Assignes by virtue of the said Charter party and  
according to the true meaning thereof and before all Custom Duties & other costs & Charges whatsoever  
as is Express'd in the said Charter party and it is further agreed by & betwixt the said parties therunto  
that all such Tobacco as the said John Addison his Exors Adms: shall load on board the said Shipps for the  
proper use & use of the said Thomas Addison his Exors Administrators & Assignes over & about the said  
Thirty four Thousand pound weight Neat Tobacco as aforesaid, shall be in part of payment &  
deducted out of the remainder Security Thousand & nine hundred pound weight Neat Tobacco & Cash  
as aforesaid, the said Thomas Addison his Exors Administrators & Assignes paying of all freight  
monye & demands proportionably to the Shipps full loading as aforesaid before all the Customs  
Duties & Charges before Express'd, In witness whereof the parties abovesaid have here to Interchangeably  
put their hands & Seals the day & year first above written
