

Maryland *ss* Know All men by these presents that I Richard Windall of Liverpools in the Kingdom of England Mariner, am holden & firmly bound unto John Addison of *ss* Marier County in the Province of Maryland aforesaid Merchant in the full & Just sum of two hundred thirty and three pounds Six shillings and eight pence of Lawfull money of England to be paid to the said John Addison or to his certain attorney his heirs Executors Adm. or assigns, to the which payment well and truly to be made I bind my selfe my heirs Executors & administrators firmly by these presents Sealed with my Seals dated the third day of Aprill in the yere of our Lord God one thousand six hundred Seventy and eight

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden Richard Windall his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Addison or to his certain attorney his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns at the Town of Liverpools in the Kingdom of England aforesaid at or before the last day of July next ensuing the date of these presents the full and Just sum of one hundred Sixtyone pounds thirtyn shillings and four pence of Lawfull money of England without fraud or delay then this present obligation to be voyd and of none effect otherwise to stand Remains and be in full force power and vertue

The Condition of this above written obligation is such that if the above bounden John Addison his heirs Executors or Administrators do: shall well and truly pay & deliver or cause to be paid & delivered unto the said Thomas Addison his heirs Executors Administrators Assigns or attorney in that behalf the full & Just quantity or number of Seventy thousand three hundred pounds weight neat good sound & merchantable loose Tobacco, & Caffe according to the Custome in Maryland aforesaid upon the River of St. Marys aforesaid or other convenient place or places in Maryland where Ships or Sloops may conveniently & safely take in the same at or before the tenth day of October which shall be in the yere of our Lord God one thousand six hundred Seventy Eight without any fraud colour or deceit in any wise, that then this present obligation shall be voyd & of none effect or else shall be remaine in full force power & vertue in the Law
