take exercise and receive the rates and sums aforesaid unto him the said Thomas
Noale and Executor of him and assigned to the only use and behoof of him the said

patents for and during the term of twenty years next ensuing and fully to be
enjoyed and ended without any account or other matter or thing to be there rendered
or paid to us our heirs or assigns or their heirs or assigns (even as to and according to the
in after mentioned) And during the term of the said letters and during the said term the
yearly rent of six shillings and eight pence to be paid unto our Exchequer in England
at the feast of St Michael the ninth yearly and the said rent to be paid for us and
heirs and assigns and for the said letters and parquets the Post Master and Post Masters
General now and for the time being of us our heirs and assigns from time to time to
the said Deputations as may better enable the said Thomas Noale and Executor
Administrators and assigned and their persons and persons as they shall from time
to time nominate to exercise and execute the power and authority to him or them
to be given and granted or intended to be given and granted
in and about the said term of twenty years and the said
doe hereby also for us our heirs and assigns fully exercise and receive all and every
person or persons whatsoever other than the said Thomas Noale and Executor of him
and assigned and their persons or persons as they shall nominate as aforesaid
to the said exercise or execute the said offices or offices within the said Islands Colonies
and plantations aforesaid or any of them at any time or times within or during
the continuance of the said term of one and twenty years hereby granted
Provided allways that nothing in the said letters or parquets shall extend or be construed
to extend to or from the said plantations or Colonies or any of them by any Masters of
ships or other vessels or by any other person or persons without the said Masters or
others will especially in case of the carriage of the same according to their
respective directions and the said Thomas Noale doth for him self his
Executor of him and assigned Covenant promise and grants to and with us our
heirs and assigns by the said letters and parquets that he the said Thomas Noale and Executor of him
or assigned or their persons or persons as they shall nominate as aforesaid shall
and will from time to time upon the or the receipt or receipts of any letters or
parquets which shall be directed into the said Islands Colonies and plantations
or any of them from England or any other parts or from any parts or places within
the said Islands Colonies or plantations to any other parts or places within the same range
the said letters or parquets to be forthwith dispatched and sent away
in the best and shortest way to the said Islands Colonies and plantations or
directed and from time to time as they or any of them shall think fit or receive
any letters or parquets to be sent from the said plantations Islands or
Colonies or any of them for England shall dispatch and send away the same by
the first ship that shall be bound for any port of England to be there
delivered to the next deputy Post Master as aforesaid and with any letters or
parquets shall be directed from any of the said Islands Colonies or plantations
to some other of them that he or they shall dispatch and send away the same
according to their respective directions by the first convenient way of carriage or conveyance
intending to the said Islands Colonies and plantations and without any neglect
intention or delay at the rates heretofore mentioned and the said Thomas Noale doth further for
himself his Executor of him and assigned Covenant promise and grants to and with us
our heirs and assigns by the said letters and parquets that he the said Thomas Noale and Executor of him
or assigned shall and will at his own costs and charges keep accounts in books
fairly written of all the sums of money and profits which shall or may arise in every
year by the said offices or employment or business aforesaid and of all charges thereupon
and shall suffer the said books to be inspected from time to time and copied thereof
or abated out of the same to be taken by such person or persons as the
Commissioners of the Treasury or High Treasurer of England for the time being shall
appoint and shall and will within the twentieth years of the said term of
twenty years hereby granted produce the said books to the said
or for many of them as shall be therein made to the Commissioners of the
Treasury or High Treasurer of England then being to the end he or they may
have certain knowledge of the yearly value of the said offices or offices for
the future benefit of us our heirs and assigns and further that such
Publick Order as the Governor of the said respective plantations Islands or
Colonies from time to time shall issue out for the immediate service of us our
heirs and assigns shall be dispatched and distributed by the said respective
Officers
