the first year of our reign entituled An Act for the abrogating the said Chal of
Supremacy and Allegiance and appointing other said Commission also that if it shall at
any time hereafter be made appear to us our Ried or Privy Seal that this our Grant
is inconvenient to our Subject in Generall or that the powers hereby granted
intended to be granted or any of them is or are abused that then it shall be
lawfull to end for us our Ried and Privy Seal by any order of or made in our or their
Privy Council to revoke determine and make such new or Letterd Pattsents and
every such power and thing therein contained to the contrary thereof in any
wise notwithstanding provided further that if the said Thomas Neale his Com^r & Edm^r
or assigned shall not within the space of two years next after the date of this our Lett
Pattsents establish the Post or Offise hereby intended within the Colonies Islands and
Plantarons aforesaid according to the tenor intent and meaning of these present then
this our grant and every power in matter and thing thereon contained shall cease to be void
any thing to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding that the said Thomas
Neale doth further faithfully his Epstn. Edm^r and assigned Commiss^r & Councill
and grants to and will for our Ried and Privy Seal that all Letterd or Parquett^r
Collected or received in any of the Plantarons Islands or Colonies aforesaid to be sent
for England shall from time to time be carefullly sent upp and delivered away by
the first Vessel bound for any port of England to be delivred to the next Post
Post master in England without any charge to the Post office here excepting and
referring unto no our Ried and Privy Seal that all Letterd or Parquett^r sent
Jland Postage of all such Letterd and Parquett^r Post mentioned to be sent for England
it being hereby intended and declared that the same shall not be accounted for the
said Thomas Neale his Epstn. Edm^r or assigned but that he and they shall and is and are
hereby obliged to satisfy and pay the same of such Vessel for such conveyance and
delivery of such Letterd and Parquett^r ad farr as sent for England ad aforesaid intended
that the said Thomas Neale his Epstn. Edm^r or assigned shall and will at
his and their owne proper cost and charges make a sufficient
Offise in our City of London to receive & collect from time to time all Letterd and
Parquett^r for any of our Colonies or Plantarons aforesaid and to take care to send
them duly away from time to time by the first vessel bound for any of the aforesaid
and further that all Letterd commonly called States Letterd which are usually carried
postage free here in England shall pass free throug all our Plantarons and
Jlands aforesaid and further also that the said Thomas Neale his Epstn. Edm^r
or assigned shall and will at the end of the three first years next
ensuing the date of these present transmit or cause to be transmitted to the
Commissioner of the Treasury or his Treasurer of England for the time being
a true and fafful account in writing upon Oath of the whole profit and advantage
arising or accersing by and the charge of Bihng and managing of the said Office
or Offises before granted or mentioned to be granted by Establishment him also
shall and will keep true & full account in writing of all the receipts & charges
aforesaid relating to the said Office or imployement etc that from and after the execution
of the said Article next ensuing after the date of this our Grant the like
amount shall be yearly from thence ad aforesaid if necessary required and for
the better execution of this powere and intention herein contained we have
given and granted and by these presents for us our Ried and Privy Seal do give and
grant to the said Thomas Neale his Epstn. Edm^r or assigned full power
to sett up make vs and have ferreyed over any River or Lake in our said Colonies
lands or Plantarons where no ferreyed are yett made nor any grante hould
for the better conveyance of passengers and postage and passenger ad need shall
be required and to keepe the profits & advantages remaining or arribing by such
ferreyed to the best of him the said Thomas Neale his Epstn. Edm^r or assigned provided
always and our will and saftey to us we do hereby for us our Ried and
Privy Seal declare that in all cases where such ferrey or ferreyed are to be sett up and
made over other person or land or water the proprieitor or Proprietors of the said shall
be first agreed with and his and their consent gained therin according to Law
Justice in witness whereof we have caused these our Lett to be made pattsents
Witness our selfe at Westminster the Seavene day of February in the
year of our Reigne of
