To all to whom these presents shall come: greeting Whereas their Majts by their letters patent under the great Seal of England bearing Date at Westminster the Seventeenth day of February in the 1st year of the
Reigne then given and granted unto Thomas Viall Esqr his Executors Administrators and assigns full
Authority to erect Sett & establish and from time to time during the terms therein mentioned to continue and
enjoy within every or any of the said ports of the Scuill Islands Plantations & Colonys belonging or to be
unto their Majts their heirs or Successors in America an officer or officers for the receiving and dispatching
of Letters and parquets with full Power and authority and free liberty leave and licence to and for him the said
Thomas Viall his Esq. Adm^r and assigns and to and for such person and persons as he or they shall from time
to time nominate to receive at the respective Officers aforesaid of and from any Master of Ships passengers
others any Letters or parquets whatsoever which should be brought into the said Colonys or Islands or any
them from England or any other parts whatsoever or which should be sent from any place or places of
same land to dispatch send away carry and deliver the same to the
respective Colonys or Island to any other port or places of the respective persons and places to whom
which they should be directed or sent within the said Colonys & Islands or any of them and to take and
receive to the only use and behoof of him the said Thomas Viall his Esq. Adm^r and assigns
the postage or conuayance of all such letters or parquets as shall be so dispatched sent away Carried and
Delivered all such rates and sumes of Money as shall be proportionable to the rates for the post or
of Letters sett downe and accustomed in and by any act of Parliament mad: in the 12th year of the
