Name and stead and to my use to performe all and do the affair and busnes
hereafter mentioned whereas Robert Burman of Mary Land aforesaid Merchant
by a certain writing under his hand and seal in London dated the twelveth day
of August 1687 in the third year of the Reigne of S^r late souaigne Lord King
James the Second of England or did for and in consideration of a certain summe in
Sume of Lawfull Money of England to him in hand buly paid also late by S^r James
transferred and set over unto the said George Copley his heirs & executors
and assigns all that tract of Land called Burmans Mountaine containing one thousand
Acre or thereabouts lying on the north side of R^r Tapstro River in the County of Batt
