firm setting the premises as aforesaid and in case the said Robert Burman shall deny to do
the same to use all such lawful ways and means for forcing him thereto as the law of the said —
Province in that case heretofore given by these presents unto my said attorney my full and
absolute power in and about the said Province Ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said
Attorney lawfully doth or cause to be done by virtue hereof in and about the premises aforesaid

This Indenture made the eighth day of May in the fifth year of the Reign of His
Sovereign Lord and Lady William and Mary by the grace of God of England Scotland —
Ireland and the Islands of the same and Queen Elizabeth of the same anno 1693 Between
Edward Barrow esq of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland Willing of the one
part and Richard Swcalnam of the County of Talbot and Province aforesaid gent of the other
part witnesseth that the said Edward Barrow the said Richard Swcalnam before the
fifties thousand pounds of Tobacco to him in hand paid by the said Richard Swcalnam before the
desaling and delivery hereof the receipt whereof he the said Edward Barrow esq —
doth hereby acknowledge and therefor acquitt and discharge the said Richard Swcalnam his
heires executors and administrators firmly by these presents hath given granted bargained sold alienated
released enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargaine sell alien
releas enfeoff and confirme unto the said Richard Swcalnam his heires & assigns for ever
except as herein after is excepted all that remaininge parts of a tract of land commonly
called and knowne by the name of Willton containinge thirty nine acres being and
parcell of Willton aforesaid first laid out for fifties acres of land begining at a marked —
white oak end running for length thirty hours perches to a Traudis braune south west eight —
Perches then running south east againe one hundred twenty five perches to an old oak then
south west fiftie perches then north west one hundred & six perches to a marked red oak by a
Branch and from the said Oak north east fiftie eight perches to the first bounded tree & then
acres of which tract of fifties acres of land called Willton is by meanes conveyance bargained and
sold
