 firme setting the premises as aforesaid and in case the said Robert Burman shall deny to doo  
 the same to use all such lawfull wayes and means for forcing him thereto as the Law of the said  
 Province in that case hath provided giving by these presents unto my said Attorney my full and  
 absolute Power in and about the said Premises Ratifying and confirming whatsover my said  
 Attorney lawfully doo or cause to be done by vertue hereof in and about the premises aforesaid

 Edward Barrowe Esq. of Calvert County in the Province of Maryland; Millner Esq. of the one  
 part and Richard Swalnam of the County of Talbot and Province aforesaid gent. of the other  
 part Witnesseth that the said Edward Barrowe Esq. for and in Consideration of the sum of  
 fiftie Thousand pounds of Tobacco to him in hand paid by the said Richard Swalnam be fore the  
 doth hereby acknowledge and therefor acquitt and discharge the said Richard Swalnam his  
 heirs Executors and Adors. firmly by these presents hath given granted bargained sold aliened  
 Released Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sold alien  
 released Enfeoffed and confirme unto the said Richard Swalnam his heirs & Assigns for ever  
 Except as here in after is excepted all that remaininge parts of a part of land commonly  
 called and knowne by the name of Willton containinge Thirty nine acres being and  
 parcell of Willton aforesaid first laid out for fiftie acres of land beginning at a marked  
 white oak end runing for length thirty fowre perches to a Trauers drawn South west eight  
 Perches then runing South East againe one hundred Twenty five perches to an old Oake then  
 South west fiftie perches then North west one hundred six perches to a marked red Oake by a  
 Branch and from the said Oake North east fiftie eight perches to the first bounded head  
 Arise of which part of fiftie Acres of land called Willton is by means Conveyance bargained and  
 sold
