made the tenth day of May in the fifth year of the
Reign of William & Mary by the grace of god of England Scotland France and Ireland King & Queen
Defend: of the faith or and in the year of our Lord One thousand six hundred ninety three between Peter
Layar of Talbot County in the Province of Maryland Gent: on the one part & Johannes Doherniofa
of the County and Province aforesaid on the other part Witnesseth that the said Peter Layar for
divers good causes & valuable considerations & more Especially for the valuable consideration of thirty
thousand pounds of good sound Monie ready and every way well conditioned to have in Cash
ready in hand paid by the said Johannes Doherniofa to the said Peter Layar the receipt whereof
of every part & part thereof the said Peter Layar by these presents doth acknowledge himselfe
to be fully ready and absolutely contented satisfied and paid & doth freely & ready and absolu-
ly acquit & discharge the said Johannes Doherniofa his heirs & assigns of and from
the same and every part and part thereof unto the said Johannes Doherniofa his heirs and
for ever by these presents Granted bargain'd & sold Alien'd & Enfeoffed and
Confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell Alienate Enfeoffe & confirm
unto the said Johannes Doherniofa his heirs & assigns for ever all that Part or parcel of Land
called Branfield formerly taken up by the said Peter Layar by him and being in Talbot County
on the North side of Cheptank River at the North West bounded tree being an Oak
and the Bounded tree of a parcel of Land formerly taken up by William Sharpe called
Mount Pleasure and running North from the said Oak tree three hundred and twenty pches
and with a line drawne from the End of the North line West four hundred pches & with
a line drawne from the End of the West line South three hundred & twenty pches until it
intersect a line drawne West from the first tree containing and laid out for Eight hundred acres
of Land and also One tract of Land taken up by the said Peter Layar called the Addition lying
in the said County and on the West side of Cheptank River in the forke of the said river beginning
at a marked white Oak being the first bounded tree of the aforesaid Land called Branfield running
thence with the said Land North four hundred pches and from the End of the North line with a line
drawne East to the River and from thence downe and the said River until it intersect a line
drawne East South East from the aforesaid marked Oak containing and laid out for two hundred
Acres of Land Together with and singular the woods and bud woods Trees and Timber
trees here for fences Orchard ways waters Easements to the same belonging together with all
rights profits members and benefits to the same in any wayes appertaining with all & all manner
of deeds writings Evidences Grants and monuments to the same belonging or in any way
appertaining to the aforesaid: two parts of Land & other the Bargain'd Premises or any part or parcel thereof

Premises
