 Maryland and his heirs and family bound unto His Majesty King William and Queen Mary or
 in the full sum of one thousand pounds Sterling Money of England to be paid to His Majesty's Parliamt
 His and Successors to the which payment well and truly to be made and done I and my self my heirs
 Exors and Adors family by these presents sealed with my Seale and dated the twelfth day of October in the
 fifth year of His Majesty's King's Annoq. Domini 1693

The condition of this Obligation is such that whereas His Majesty by His Letters Patents have Committed the Office
 of Secretary of Maryland to the above bound Thomas Laurence to be by him held and enjoyed during His Majesty's Royal pleasure
 and unto the said Thomas Laurence to take and receive into his possession and Care all the Bonds Certificates and other
 Deeds and Papers whatsoever belonging unto the condition of this Obligation is such that if the said Thomas Laurence do
 in all things according to the Obligation and duty of his said Office well and truly observe perform and execute the same either
 by himself or such Clerks as he will answer for without fraud or Error and well and truly register and deliver the said
 Office and all Bonds and other papers writings and Deeds which shall be to him delivered together with what shall be
 received taken or enrolled during his continuance therein unto His Majesty's Parliamt or his heirs or assigns to the said
 Thomas shall be lawfully discharged therefrom that this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and
 virtue
