To all Christian People

to whom these presents shall come William Blathwayt Esq. Surveyor and Auditor General of their Majties Revenues arising in America under the Great Seal of England bearing date the thirtieth day of May in the two and thirtieth year of their Majties Kings and Grants unto him the said William Blathwayt the Office of Surveyor and Auditor General of the Revenues of their Majties his Majties and Surrejoys arising in America with full power and authority to inspect examine State and Audit and with the allowance and consent of the Lord High Treasurer Comissioners of the Treasury and Chancellor of the Exchequer for the time being to determine all and singular Accounts of all such Revenues Prizes fines and Duties forbitwys and profits whatsover as well by reason of any matter or thing happened since the beginning of the first War that was betwixt the said Majties and the States Generall of the United Provinces and not before and w^{ch} should at any time become due or payable to his said Majties his Majties and Surrejoys during the continuance of the said Letters patent in or from all or any of the said Majties Dominions Islands Colonies and Plantations in America and by all lawfull wayes and means to cause the same to be recovered and paid to the proper Officers for the use of the said Majties his Majties and Successors. To have and to hold the said Office to him the said William Blathwayt by himself or his sufficient Deputy or Deputies for and during the time and so long as the said William Blathwayt should well behave himself in the said Office with further power in the said Letters patent contained for him the said William Blathwayt from time to time to constitute and appoint by any writing under his hand and Seal such Inferiour Officers for the better expediting and carrying on the said Service in relation to the said Office as by Nomination Warrant and Direction from the Lord High Treasurer of England or Comissioners of the Treasury for the time being to the said William Blathwayt should be directed and the said Inferiour Officers from time to time to suspend Remove and Displace as to him the said William Blathwayt with allowance and direction of the Lord High Treasurer or Comissioners of the Treasury for the time being should be thought necessary and expedient. Note Note that the said William Blathwayt for the more effectuall execution and performance of the premises and for the better expediting and carrying on the said Service shall by the said Nomination Warrant and Direction of the right Hon^{ble} the Lord Comissioners of the Treasury constituted and appointed and doth by these presents constitute and appoint Edward Randolph Esq. to be his Deputy and Under Officer within their Majties Province of Maryland for the purpose and to the end hereafter mentioned and no other (that is to say) that the said Edward Randolph shall and the said William Blathwayt doth hereby give and Grant full power and authority to the said Edward Randolph to inspect examine and State all Accounts of such Revenues Prizes fines and Duties forbitwys and profits whatsover as well by reason or cause of any matter or thing happened or fallen since the beginning of the said first War that was betwixt the said Majties and the said States and not before or within at any time from and after the date of the said Letters patent here happened fallen or shall hereafter happen fall or
