 greeting know ye that I Maria Anna Dominica otherwise Viscountess Widow residing  
 in the City of London do hereby constitute and appoint my loving Brother in Law  
 Robert Carville of St Mary County in the Province of Maryland my true and lawfull  
 Attorney for me and in my name to bargain and sell all my Right Title and Interest  
 of in or to all that parcel of Land called Poplars Island lying in the County of Kent  
 in the same Province of Maryland appertaining by the death of my father to him person  
 or persons and for sum of Sum of Tobacco as my said Attorney shall see thought meet  
 and the Debt or Debt of the same fee to be made for me and in my name to be delivered and  
 before any Judge or Justice to acknowledge and all such Sum or Sum of Tobacco as shall  
 be due to me for my share or proportion of the purchase money to be paid for the  
 same or any other Sum or Sum of Tobacco due to me from my Brother Alexander  
 Dominica or any other what so ever in the said Province in Maryland for me and  
 in my name and to my use to the Demand of the said Justice and Receiver and  
 Arriphants and officers for the same in my name to give Seal and deliver giving  
 hereby to my said Attorney my full power and authority touching and concerning the  
 premises to do execute and perform in as ample manner as if I were personally  
 present and what my said Attorney shall lawfully do in and touching the premises  
 do hereby Ratify and confirm in witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand and Seal the eighth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand six  
 hundred eighty and eight In witness whereof Maria Anna Dominica sealed with a Seal  
 the said printed and in the Margin under written Seal and delivered in  
 the presence of us Sufficient John Walsgrave and Adam Spence English Merchant  
 of London in England

 last before us the Chief Officers of their Majesties Customs in the port of  
 Beaulieu Richard Glanville Master or Comander of the Ship or Vessel called  
 the John David Burthen fourtie sum of Tons about mounted with 100 Guns  
 Navigated with six men plantation built and produced of Brittain and  
 made vath that at that time went to the said Beaulieu to their Majesties use on or about  
 the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1692 with Evidence that all such Sugars Tobacco Cotton Wool  
 Indico Ginger Mustick or other drying Wood of the growth production or Manufacture  
 of any English plantation in America Asia or Africa as shulls be laden on board  
 the said Ship or Vessel or any of the said English plantations shulls be brought  
 to some port of England Wales or port or town of Berwick upon Tweed and  
 there unloaded and put on Shore the dangers of the Seas only excepted and  
 it is hereby further certified that there hath been
