 assurance and assurances or conveyances in the law whatsoever for such further Act
 and conveying the before hereby granted or mentioned to be granted premises with
 their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Lord Mayor and his heirs to the
 only proper use and behoofe of the said Lord Mayor his heirs and Assignes for ever
 the acknowledgment and enrollment of these presents or by or any other lawfull wayes
 and means whatsoever as by the said Lord Mayor his heirs or Assignes or his or their
 Council learned in the law shall be reasonably advised or advised and required
