 the whole firmly by these presents Sealed with my Seals & dated this twelfth

 Ninety and Three.

The condition of this obligation is such that whereas the said Hugh  
 Hopewell by his last Will & Testament bearing date the Thirtieth  
 day of May Anno Dni 1687 after several legacies thereby given & bequeathed
