This Indenture made the twentieth day of September in the sixth year of the Reign
of our Sovereign Lord and Lady William and Mary King and Queen of England &c.
Ann^o Dom^o 1694 between Tobias Grentzen of the Parish of St. Peter in the County of
part and Thomas Patman of the Parish of St. Andrew's in the County of
that the said Tobias Grentzen being a single person and all unmarried &
hath and by these presents doth bind and put himself an apprentice & servant
to the said Thomas Patman to be his or his Assigns in the plantation of
Maryland beyond the Sea for the space of Six Years not including the arrivall
of the said Tobias Grentzen in the said plantation and doth hereby covenant
well and truly to be to the said Thomas Patman or his lawful Assigns in the
said plantation for and during the said term according to the Laws and Customs
of the said plantation and doth further declare and covenant that he the said
Tobias Grentzen at the time of the embarking thereof of the said Six Years
a single person & unmarried & no servant or apprentice servant to any other
person or persons. And the said Thomas Patman for himself his Executors and Assigns
in consideration thereof doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said
Tobias Grentzen that he the said Thomas Patman or his Assigns shall and will at
his or their own proper costs and charges with what course might speed they may
carry and convey or cause to be carried or conveyed over unto the said plantation
the said Tobias Grentzen and from thence forth and during the said voyage and after
during the said term and at the end thereof shall & will at the like costs and charges
provide for and allow the said Tobias Grentzen all necessary food that drink
washing lodging and other necessary of fit and convenient for him according to
the custom of the said plantation and as other servants in such cases are usually
provided for and allowed In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set
their hands and seals this day and year above written.
