

Seven years and an half now not ending shall be taken up gotten  
 or recovered and other than and except all such works gold silver  
 goods and any other matters or things as aforesaid which have been  
 or shall be left wast away wrought or left in any other party or places  
 whatsoever where any person or persons by virtue of any Grant  
 or other sufficient authority from their said Maties have already  
 power to take up gain or recover the same and which shall be taken up  
 gained or recovered within the time or times by such Grant or Grants  
 strictly limited and except all the party and process which are  
 respects of the same or any of them to their said Maties their heirs  
 and Successors And also excepting and reserving unto their said Maties  
 their heirs and Successors one full tenth part of all and every the said  
 works riches Treasures goods and premises aforesaid to be taken up  
 gotten and recovered by virtue of these presents And our said Sovereign  
 Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary of their further special  
 grace certain knowledge and mere motion have given and granted  
 and by these presents do give and grant full power licence and  
 authority unto him the said Marquess Duke of Cambridge his Executors  
 Administrators and Assignes and such Agents Deputyes Servants and Substitutes  
 as he or they have appointed or shall appoint in this behalf at his and  
 their own proper cost and charge to sail and repare from time to time  
 to the parts before mentioned to search for take recover and possess  
 themselves of the said riches goods merchandise and premises before mentioned  
 to be by these presents granted every or any of them and every or any part  
 thereof that is or shall be left wast away wrought or left as aforesaid  
 (except before excepted) And the said Marquess Duke of Cambridge doth for  
 himself his heirs Executors Administrators and Assignes for want promise and  
 Grant to and with their said Maties their heirs and Successors by these  
 presents that he the said Marquess Duke of Cambridge his Executors Administrators  
 or Assignes shall and will at their own or their own proper cost and charge  
 from time to time during the time hereby granted do his and their best  
 endeavours in order to the finding gaining taking up and recovery of the  
 premises and that a true and faithful account and Receipt shall be kept  
 in writing of all such silver gold and other riches or Treasures matters and  
 things whatsoever as shall be taken up gained or recovered by virtue of  
 this Grant and be delivered to their said Maties their heirs and Successors  
 upon oath (if it shall be required) And also that all the gold silver and  
 other riches Treasures and goods as shall be found as aforesaid recovered  
 within the time and limits and places aforesaid shall be brought home  
 into the port of London the hazard of the Seas restraint of pirates and  
 other Enemies piracy and accidental fire only excepted And that one  
 full tenth part thereof without any deduction Disfalvation or abatement  
 whatsoever shall be well and truly payed and delivered to the use of  
 their said Maties their heirs and Successors or to whom their said Maties  
 their heirs or Successors or the Comissioners of the Treasury or high  
 Treasurer of England for the time being shall direct that the  
 remaining nine parts thereof shall and may be retained and kept by the  
 said Marquess Duke of Cambridge his Executors Administrators or Assignes  
 to his and their own use without any matter account matter or thing to be  
 rendered for the same And the said King and Queen most excellent  
 Maties do hereby require and Comand all Governours of their Islands  
 and
