 hereby granted and that none of the Officy or Subjcty whatsover
 of their Maties their heire or Successors doe presume in any wise
 to impede or hinder the same as they will crowd their Maties right
 displeasur and such punishment as may be inflicted. Provided -
 always and their said Maties intent and meaning is that any person
 or persons whom the Comissioners of their Maties Treasury or High
 Treasurer of England for that time being shall appoint shall and may
 inspect the fishing for and taking up of the said Werra for the better
 serving their Maties said South part thereof from Imberlment
 according to the true intent and meaning of these parts. And the said
 King and Queen most excellent Maties doe hereby Grant that the said
 Maimhardt Duke of Linsfor his Agents Substitutes and Assigny shall and
 may proceed in the due execution of the power and Authority hereby
 granted any former order or Direction or other matter or thing to the
 contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding In witness or Witness
 our selues at Westminster the tenth day of March by Writte of
 priuie Seale Nos autem tenorem Inroflamen p'dict had equisrosim
