Thomas Laurence his heirs Ex<sup>ty</sup> or Adm<sup>ty</sup> doe and shall well and truly within or at the Expiration of twelve Months from the Receipt of the said one hundred pound Sterd. upon the said Bills satisfy and pay to the said Francis Nicholson Esq. his heirs or Assignes the said sume of one hundred pound Sterd Money of England with Lawfull Interest for the same without fraud or Coins.
