the hon. Mr. Nigold Scovell of Calvert County aforesaid Esq. in his sum
of four hundred pounds of lawfull money of England to be paid to the
said Mr. Nigold or his written attorney executors or assignees to white paper
well and truly to be made & bind me my heirs executors and administrators
every of us firmly by these presents sealed with my hand dated the 18th
Eighteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred
Eighty and five — /

If therefore there is a marriage by good grace shortly to be had & solemnized between
the above bound Henry Lowe and Susanna Darwall widow and relict of John
Darwall deceased with whom the said Henry is to reside as a marriage portion a
compttal estate aforesaid by settlement of law and custom of the same persons for ad of a
personall estate whereof the same is now possessed Now the condition of this obligation
is such that if the said marriage shall take effect and the said Susanna & shall
happen to depart this life and leave the said Henry her surviving and no before
her death shall be legally interred ad of her in all those lands wherof the
said Susannah is now seized then if the said Henry Lowe within twelve moneths
after the death of the said Susannah shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid
unto and amongst such of the children that shall be begotten between the said
Henry and Susannah as the said Susannah in or by her last will & testament or
other will purporting her last will under her hand & seal in the presence of two or
more credible witnesses shall leave & bequeath to each child unto the sum of One
hundred pounds of currant money of England with interest thereon by such
proportion and in such manner and forme and to such uses intents and purposes
as the said shall be by her bequeathed amongst the children aforesaid if any
such child or children shall be dead also shall pay the sum of One hundred
pounds more of the currant money of England for their twelve moneths after
the death of the said Susannah to such person or persons as the said Susannah
by such her said last will & testament or writing shall leave will and give her
said unto by such proportion in such manner & to such uses intents and purposes
as the said shall be by her bequeathed amongst the children aforesaid if the said Henry Lowe
shall suffer the said Susannah to make such will or writing aforesaid to be
legally probated by the executors or administrators named therein then this present obligation
to be void and of none effect or else it to stand and abide in full force & credit /
