hereby provided that if the said Edward Green shall send a list and true account of all such Works with Whales or
other Royall Fish as either he or his assigns or for the future have or shall have in his possession Wholesome an Advantage
or benefit unto him the said Edward Green that any time hereunto shall be made or hereafter shall be made
with the Major Court of Vice Admiralty on the Eastern Shore and pay there part thereof unto the Major Court
without fraud or deceit as unto the Major Court shall be thought due and the Vice Admirall Whales shall be
as but then the above obligation to be paid otherwise to stand and remain in full force & virtue

This Indenture

made the first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred Ninety four -
Between William Joseph of Albion County Esq: of the one part and Charles Carroll of St. Marys County Gent: of the other
part Witnesseth that the said William Joseph for and in consideration of the full sum of fifteen hundred pounds of lawful
tender money unto him the said Charles Carroll the receipt whereof and every part and parcel thereof he doth hereby
acknowledge and stand bound and of every part and parcel thereof doth freely and cheerly acquit discharge
him the said Charles Carroll by these presents hath granted bargained sold conveyed confirmed and confirmed by these presents
doth grant bargain sell convey confirm and confirm unto him the said Charles Carroll All that tract or parcel of land
called the Forest of Joseph lying in part of the County of St. Marys on the East side of the Bay of the West side of
the River and two miles from Christopher Muttons plantation and running towards the said Forest South
West and by South three hundred and twenty five feet and by South East eight hundred feet and by North
Other Maines branch of the said River thence with the said Forest North East and by North three hundred
and twenty five feet thence with a straight line to the first boundary containing and now laid out for
the said Forest of Joseph at the City of St. Marys bearing East the length of the said Forest of Joseph
the hundred eighty and nine and three remaining upon record which said Forest of Joseph of the said
was a forward there is to pay upon the first day of June in the said last written year pastured
under the great Seal of this Province unto him the said Wm Joseph together with all Woods
underwood Marshes Swamps Rights profits benefits privileges advantages and appurtenances whatsoever
to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining in as large & simple manner as the same is held
by the said Wm Joseph from the Right Hon: Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore Proprietary of this
Province and his heirs and assigns forever to have and to hold of said Forest of Joseph
land with all and singular the premises appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise
appertaining granted or allowed by these presents to be granted and conveyed unto the said Charles Carroll his
heirs for ever to his only proper use and behoof of him the said Charles Carroll and his heirs and to his other
uses intents or purposes whatsoever AND the said Wm Joseph his heirs and assigns doth and doth hereby
these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns that he the
said William Joseph his heirs and assigns shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit
discharge and save harmless as well the said Tract of Land and Premises with all and singular their
appurtenances and every part and parcel thereof as also the said Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns and
them and of and from all manner of former bargains sales promises covenants conditions and all
other litters charges and demands whatsoever that he knoweth or knoweth or shall be made by the said Wm
or by his assigns present or to come at any time or times (the said Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns and
heirs and assigns shall be the Lord Proprietary of this Province or that shall hereafter grow due unto him only excepted and
excepted) And that the said Wm Joseph his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant defend and defend unto the said Charles Carroll
and his heirs the said Tract of Land and Premises with all and singular the Rights Monies and appurtenances
of every part and parcel thereof without any lawful title or title or disturbance or disturbance of the said
Wm Joseph or his heirs or of any other Person or persons whatsoever claiming by from or under him the
