third year of their Majesty King William and Queen Mary
the within Named John Galwith the wife of the within Named John Galwith before
us present Justice and Wm Parker two of their Majesty Justices of the
peace for the County of Middlesex in the presence of Mary Lewis and being by us
specially examined out of the Advancing of her said husband did acknowledge
the within written Indentures to be her Act and Book and that she
did freely and voluntarily resigne all & singular her right titles &
interest of in or to the within mentioned Sir Brookes parson or Party
of Land and the appurtenances thereto belonging without being
forced or thereto induced by force or threats of her said husband

Day & year aforesaid 1691

and certify that on the Day of the said Indentures in their Majesty Court
