some further Endorsement on the said Country and by me to be made in the  
Provincial Court that it may be there Recorded all according to Law I do hereby  
constitute and appoint my said attorney in my Name to Act & Acknowledge the  
same as the Law in that case Provides holding for good and good what my  
said Attorney shall lawfully doe and Act in Affirming the said as it I were  
then personally present and had acted the same my self without my hands  
and Seals this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September anno Domini 1696
