Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Litchworth of Calvert County planter having for  
a Negro a Malattoe and other Goods amounting to the sum of Eighty eight pounds Sterling Money  
of England in hand Received Assigned and made Obed to Philip Lynds of Charles County Merchant for  
consideration of Satisfaction for the same our Obligation of Mr Ignatius Cayerosts of Calvert County  
dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 1694 for Sixty pounds Sterling and three bills of Exchange all of our hand and Seal  
drawn by Thomas Sawney on Samuel Groom dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1694 and payable after twenty  
days Eight for twenty eight pounds of Sterling Current Money of England both sums makes up Eighty  
eight pounds which is the sum of the value of the said Lynds as of and in case either the said  
Cayerosts or the said Sawney or both of them or that Samuel Groom should not pay the said sum of  
Money as for the said Lynds Recovery of the same or any part thereof being not punctually paid  
according to the bond of the Obligation and bills of Exchange as I do hereby constitute and ordain  
him the said Lynds to be my true and lawfull atty prolocutor and to his the said Lynds own proper  
use and behoofe one or more attys give him ~~power~~ full power and authority and in my name appoint  
for the more better Recovery of the said Debt or any of them to sue Implead and Imprison any of them for  
the same and out of Prison again as he seeth cause them against to Release discharge in my name  
to Sign Seal and Deliver and all other matters what soever herein omitted that ought to have been  
herein mentioned I hereby Ratify and Confirm and Confirm by these presents in as ample manner  
as if it were herein inserted holding and Ratifying all for good that my said atty shall lawfully do  
or cause to be done in the Premises as if I were there personally present as witness my hand and Seal  
this Seventh day of September 1695
