Memorandum, The 17th Day of June in the fourth year of our Reigne Annus
Domini 1692 James Elizabeth Baron before me John Fleet Knight and Mayor
of the City of London And then and there acknowledged this

This Indenture

made the second Day of November Anno Domini 1695
in the seventh year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord William the Third by the
Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith
the said William the Third (the eldest of Prior Charles in the County of Worcester
husbandman and the only brother and heir of Richard Charles the last of
Barons of Maryland in the County of Salter in the County of Down in Swainson
County Merchant Trades and Mary the Wife of the said John Charles
Richard King of London Wyndrower and Katherine his Wife John Seller
of Prior Charles aforesaid husbandman and Mary his Wife Nathaniel
Brian of London Gent: and Francis his Wife (where said Katherine Mary
and Francis were three of the Executors of the said Richard Charles at the time
of his Death of the one part and Edward Carlston of London Merchant of
the other part Witnesseth that the said John Charles and Mary his Wife
King and Katherine his Wife John Seller and Mary his Wife and Nathaniel
Brian and Francis his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
and eighty five pounds of Lawfull Money of England to them in hand paid
by the said Edward Carlston at and before the signing and delivery of these
Articles in Manner and Form following that is to say the said John Charles
the sum of forty pounds to the said Richard King and Katherine his Wife
the sum of twenty five pounds to the said John Seller and Mary his
Wife the sum of twenty five pounds to the said Nathaniel Brian
Francis his Wife the sum of twenty pounds to the wife whereof they do
widely severally and respectively acknowledge according and therewith of every
part thereof to be lawfully acquitted Creditors and Debts of the said Edward
Carlston by him and every of them for ever by these Articles here granted
solely enjoyed and confirmed And by these Articles doth each every
of them doth fully freely and absolutely grant release dispose and confirm
unto the said Edward Carlston (in his actual possession now being by
virtue of a Bargain and Sale to him thereof made by the
said John Charles and Mary his Wife Richard King and Katherine his
Wife and John Seller and Mary his Wife and Nathaniel Brian
the Day before the Day of the Date hereof And by force of the

Statute
